London Art Fair

January 18 – 22

In its 29th year, the U.K.'s top fair for modern British and international contemporary art expands its reach, showcasing works from 129 galleries—one fifth of which come from outside the region (China, France, South Korea, and Barcelona, to name a few of the locales represented). Highlights this year include Korean artist Jaye Moon's street sculptures made of LEGOs; a partnership with The Lightbox celebrating the tenth anniversary of the major Woking gallery; the "Dialogues" projects, intended to foster new ways of presentation and global relationships among galleries; and "Stranger Collaborations," an exhibition of artistic collaborations born from the internet.
